In order for the Republican party to fulfill its obligations to its base, the opposition must be eliminated. Great strides are being made in doing just that!

- 80% of all votes in the United States are counted by only two companies: Diebold and ES&S.
- There is no federal agency with regulatory authority or oversight of the U.S. voting machine industry
- The vice president of Diebold and the president of ES&S are brothers
- The Chairman and CEO of Diebold is a major Bush campaign organizer and donor who wrote in 2003 that he was “Committed to helping Ohio deliver its electoral votes to the President next year”.
- Republican Senator Chuck Hagel used to be chairman of ES&S. He became Senator of Nebraska based on votes counted by ES&S.
- Republican Senator Chuck Hagel, long-associated with the Bush family and once on a short list of George W. Bush’s potential vice-presidential candidates, was recently caught lying about his ownership of ES&S by the Senate Ethics Committee.
- ES&S is the largest voting machine manufacturer in the U.S. and counts almost 60% of all U.S. votes.
- Diebold (who makes ATMs, checkout scanners, and ticket machines, all of which log each transaction and can create a paper trail) touch screen voting machines have no paper trail for any votes. In other words, there is no way to verify data coming out of the machine is the same as what was legitimately put in by voters.
- Diebold is based in Ohio.
- 30% of all U.S. votes are carried out on unverifiable touch screen voting machines with no paper trail.
- Diebold employed five convicted felons as consultants and developers to help write the central compiler computer code that counted 50% of the votes in 30 states.
- Jeff dean was Senior Vice-president of General Elections systems when it was bought by Diebold. Even though he had been convicted of 23 counts of felony theft in the first degree, Jeff dean was retained as a consultant by Diebold and was largely responsible for the optical scanning software now used in most of the United States.
- Diebold consultant Jeff Dean was convicted of planting back doors in his software and using “a high degree of sophistication” to evade detection over a period of two years.
- California banned the use of Diebold voting machines because the security was faulty.
- Software programmer Clinton Curtis admitted in a notarized affidavit that he was directed by (then future republican congressman) Tom Feeney to develop a prototype “vote stealing” program that could “flip” votes from a winning candidate to the losing candidate. He also claimed that Tom Feeney had “exclusion lists” for reducing or blocking the “black vote”.
- None of the international election observers were allowed in the polls in Ohio.
- Local news media was barred from the ballot count in Warren County , Ohio due to a bogus terrorist threat. The FBI later confirmed that there was no threat.
- Bush received 4258 votes one Ohio county in 2004. Yet only 638 voters cast ballots
- All –not some– ALL the voting machine errors detected and reported in Florida went in favor of Bush and Republican candidates.
- Serious voting anomalies in Florida - again always favoring Bush - have been mathematically demonstrated and experts are recommending further investigation.
- All exit polls matched in the 2004 election with the exception of Florida and Ohio.
